

Let me start with a public service announcement. Don't forget to turn your clocks ahead one hour before you go to bed on Saturday night, April 1. It seems peculiarly appropriate that we have a time change in April, since April is usually the month for Easter. As we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus, we recognize that an enormous change has taken place in history. It's as if the ordinary course of time itself has been altered. We used to know what to expect. You live. Then you die. Birth is the beginning. Death is the end. But with the resurrection, we are thrown into a new time, a whole new era, a brand new way of seeing everything. Death isn't the end. That's certainly a big part of this new way of seeing. And we can know that we worship a God who isn't bound by anything, a God who calls us into this wonderful adventure of following our risen Lord.
