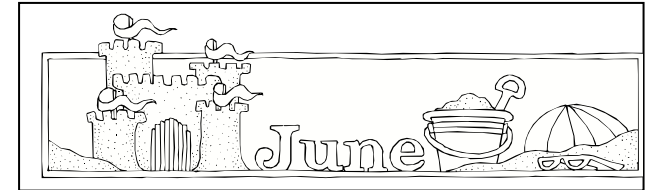

## MARK'S MUSINGS

I was at a gas station the other day and had a nice chat with the loan officer stationed at the pumps. He was offering some fairly attractive terms on purchasing a full tank of gas, but unfortunately my old car wasn't sufficient collateral, so I had to settle for half a tank and a Diet Mountain Dew. OK, seriously, we're all astounded at the price of gasoline these days. And the effects are beginning to show in a number of ways. The U.S. Department of Transportation reports that the number of miles driven in March dropped more than 4 per cent, or 11 billion miles, from March 2007, the first such decline since 1979. People are making choices about skipping vacations or not going as far on vacation. The cost affects our decisions.

I'll say that again. The cost affects our decisions. And now I'm not talking about gasoline, but about what Dietrich Bonhoeffer called "the cost of discipleship". What does it cost us to follow Jesus? If we see discipleship as easy and grace as cheap, are we more likely to claim loyalty to Jesus? What does it cost us to follow Jesus? Our whole lives? Dallas Willard has suggested that we also need to take into account what he calls "the cost of non-discipleship." What will it cost us to fail to follow Jesus? What will we miss? What will we lose? Jesus said, "For those who want to save their life will lose it, and those who lose their life for my sake will find it. For what will it profit them if they gain the whole world but forfeit their life? Or what will they give in return for their life?" The cost affects our decisions. May God help us choose wisely and well.
