We are currently busily filling our shoeboxes for Operation Christmas Child at this writing. Help us put a smile on a child's face this Christmas who otherwise would receive nothing. Note—the deadline is **November 10**.

Carole and Jane have been attending meetings regarding the Baptist Toy Store and have been pleasingly educated on the "backbones" of the operation. We have learned there is no double dipping permitted meaning parents can receive only from one organization. The PMBA Toy Store provides toys to children birth through middle school teens with suggested costs of \$10 to \$25 each; however, stocking stuffers are also needed for those who want to participate but cannot afford a toy donation. We have been furnished suggestions of the most needed gifts along with items not desired.
