We can pick up on Wed., Th., or Fri. between 9-11:30 or 2-3:30. I am so grateful that Dale Lakey was able to help me with the initial 20 case food pick up last Thursday (we fed 47 kids this past weekend!), but it was a LOT for just the two of us. Ideally we'd find someone with a box truck or a flatbed...AWESOME, BUT pickup trucks, vans, SUVs, cars, etc. will work just as well. HOWEVER, if we use uncovered trucks, we must take tarps and tie downs to cover the boxes- no biggie, though. We need to give Daisy @ 2nd Harvest about 5 days notice before we pick up the food. PLEASE consider helping me if at all possible. Or if you know of someone who might be willing to volunteer their time or truck, please let me know. If you can work it out to spare an hour or so let me know **what days/times you are available**. I will hopefully be able to get a few people that can come on the same day and time and we'll be set. As you keep supporting this ministry, please remember our endeavors are being gratefully appreciated since almost every month we receive thank you letters from the Homes and there is no way to measure the untold gratification that comes from family members as they read the short note on each item denoting the UCBC donation. Mark your calendar our next "Cookies for Hospice" will be **Sunday, October 5**.

Jean Foster delivered two full baskets of donated items to Senior Services on September 17. Again, another successful mission project "*under our belt*." Also, you will recall our June and July mission emphasis for the PMBA food pantry. A total of \$458 from our church members was donated in addition to all the food items—WONDERFUL!

Inward missions were our main project in September, meaning our concentration was on our shut in families. On Wednesday, September 10, home cooked meals were delivered to 8 UCBC members' homes. Thank you to everyone who participated in the food preparation and the home visits. The WOM kindly requests that we always keep our shut ins utmost in our thoughts and prayers. We will be making this an ongoing mission.

We are also proud to report the WOM ladies decided to take advantage of a fantastic sale on transport chairs. Since there have been multiple requests to borrow one from our Medical Missions Supplies inventory and we were not able to assist due to unavailability, \$89.99 in WOM funds was used to make a purchase. Additionally, Beverly Weavil purchased a second one in Ken's memory so we now have two additional transport chairs available for loan.

Continuing with our partnership, on September 22, homemade breads, cookies, coffee, soft drinks, nabs and candy were once again delivered to WFBMC PICU staff along with hygiene kits for trauma patient family members.

Wednesday night, October 1 will be our next meeting, immediately following the fellowship supper.
