Just a bit more information about the success of the Baptist Toy Store this past December: 2,323 children received gifts, there were 9 professions of faith and 30+ parents requested follow ups. Additionally, 328 food boxes were given out plus hygiene products. Without the donations from our church and others in the Pilot Mountain Baptist Association, this would not have been possible!

During January, we continued our Inward Missions by preparing meals for some of our church members, plus an elderly couple outside of our church who had need of assistance. It is our hope to be able to faithfully continue this ministry on a regular basis.

Also, on January 22, we delivered 12 hygiene kits, a prayer journal and personal clothing items for mothers of trauma patients at the Brenner's Pediatric ICU and the Intermediate ICU units. We also supplied the staff with homemade breads, cake, chips, nabs, and muffins, along with coffee, sodas and chocolate candy. This delivery, of course, was a continuance of our spiritual partnership with the PICU staff.

Please note our annual Tea generally held on Baptist Women's Day in February has been moved to Saturday, May 2 this year. However, please watch your bulletins as we hope to observe Baptist Women's Day on February 22 in other special ways.

Our next WOM meeting will be **February 4** and all ladies are welcome to join as we plan other mission projects.
